Dear Dr. Federoff:

This is in reference to your current financial assurance instrument, an escrow account. Escrow accounts will no longer be acceptable as of December 17, 2012. The NRC published the new financial assurance rules in the Federal Register Notice dated June 17, 2011 [(Volume 76, No. 117, pages 35512 – 35573) ADAMS Accession Number ML121350224]. The NRC is revising 10 CFR 30.35 which applies to your Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 08-03114-05. Please review the Federal Register Notice and provide the NRC with a new financial assurance instrument. Respond before September 1, 2012. We must review, resolve any discrepancies, and approve your new financial assurance instrument before December 17, 2012. You were first notified of the above requirement in our April 13, 2012, letter which accompanied your license amendment renewing the license. The letter, however, did not indicate when a response should be submitted.
