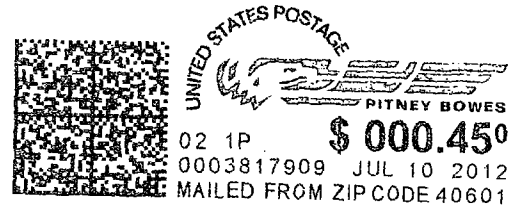
Your interest in maintaining a dialogue and collaboration with CRCPD is very important to us and is greatly appreciated. We look forward to working with you during your term as Chairman.
