Dear Mr. Vogel,

This letter is written in response to your letter dated June 28, 2012 received in reference to the compliance requirements of BP Gulf of Mexico general license covering our sealed sources contained within fixed subsea gauging devices.

NRC regulations required that the vendor, Roxar, Inc., report any transfers of generally licensed devices to the NRC. As such, in January 2012, Roxar, Inc., reported the transfer of the above mentioned sources to BP Exploration and Production between 2002 and 2003.

This letter serves to acknowledge that we understand the requirements of our general license as outlined in 10 CFR 31.5. We also acknowledge the receipt of these devices from Roxar Inc., as well as the requirement that BP shall ensure that a proper general license label be affixed to these devices in the event that they are returned to the surface as per 10 CFR 31.5.
