**JOINTLY PROPOSED SCHEDULE  
FOR SUBMITTAL OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

In Memorandum and Order (Requesting Further Information from the Applicant), issued by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) on June 29, 2012, the Board ordered the parties in the above-captioned proceeding to file additional information with the Board. The Board proposed a schedule for submittal of the additional filings, but invited the parties to notify the Board if a different schedule was required "given the effort needed."<sup>1</sup> The Board requested that, by July 11, 2012, the parties provide notice in writing of their intent to adhere to the schedule suggested by the Board, or propose a jointly recommended alternative schedule for the further conduct of this proceeding.<sup>2</sup>

The parties have conferred and agree that additional time is required to provide the information sought by the Board's Order. Accordingly, the parties agree to the schedule provided below:



Applicant to file the documents requested by the Board's June 29, 2012 Order, along with supporting testimony and evidence	Monday, October 15, 2012
Staff to file its response to Applicant's submittals	Wednesday, December 19, 2012
Intervenors to file its response to Applicant's submittals and the Staff's response	Thursday, January 31, 2013
Applicant to file its reply to the Staff and Intervenors' responses	Thursday, February 14, 2013

Additionally, the parties note that because the exact content and nature of the Applicant's filing is yet unknown, certain parties may find it necessary to request modifications to this schedule at a later date. The parties will continue to work in good faith to come to agreement on such modifications, if sought.

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
