(08:15) Mr. Hill returned my call and got Mr. Regits in through a conference call. I explained that there was a change in policy concerning how the NRC processes voids of licensing actions. As directed by NRC headquarters, the Regions are now required to obtain a written request from the licensee, in order to void a licensing action, otherwise, the action would need to be denied. The Regions can no longer unilaterally void requests. You requested that an e-mail with the request for the letter be sent to you with language that might be used in the request to void the action. I stated that I would draft such an e-mail but that a response from them should be faxed to the Region I office today.
