SUBJECT: NRC PARTICIPATION IN COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA URANIUM  
WORKING GROUP PUBLIC MEETING ON AUGUST 2, 2012

Dear Mr. Ecker:

The Governor of Virginia, in a January 19, 2012 letter, established a Uranium Working Group (UWG) to further study uranium mining and milling in Virginia, and whether it would be in the best interest of the Commonwealth of Virginia to lift the moratorium on uranium mining. The UWG has scheduled a series of public meetings and has invited the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to participate in the August 2, 2012 meeting in Chatham, Virginia. During this meeting, the NRC plans to discuss the uranium recovery program, applicable regulations, operation of a conventional mill, and the Agreement State program. It is our understanding that the August 2, 2012 meeting will include a public comment period. Hopefully, our participation in this meeting will address the concerns which prompted your March 2, 2012 letter to the NRC.
