Dear Mr. Popp:

On July 15, 2010, we terminated NRC License Number 24-32439-01, issued to Pharmacia Corporation. At that time we returned the Letter of Credit Number 103149-793 and the standby Trust Agreement Account Number E01471 to Pfizer. However, we neglected to return the pending decommissioning financial assurance (DFA) in the form of a Parent Company Guarantee (PCG). The PCG was valued at \$750,000, dated April 7, 2005 and March 27, 2006. A revised PCG valued at \$1,125,000, dated March 23, 2007, was also pending. Due to the license having been terminated, the DFA is no longer required and this pending action will not be reviewed. As a result of the termination, we are returning the enclosed previously submitted PCG dated April 7, 2005, March 27, 2006, and March 23, 2007.
