Subject: Revision of the Final Closure Plan for the US-APWR Seismic and Structural Analyses

Reference: 1) Letter (MHI Ref: UAP-HF-12082) from Yoshiki Ogata to U.S. NRC, "Final Closure Plan for the US-APWR Seismic and Structural Analyses" dated March 31, 2012

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC of Mitsubishi Heavy Industries', Ltd. (MHI) intention to revise the "Final Closure Plan for the US-APWR Seismic and Structural Analyses" (reference 1). MHI is incorporating minor changes to the US-APWR design that impact the seismic work outlined in reference 1. As a result of the changes, the submittal dates provided in reference 1 need to be revised. MHI will submit a revised Final Closure Plan for the US-APWR Seismic and Structural Analyses to the NRC by the end of August 2012.


In the interim, MHI is notifying the NRC that the following reports will not be submitted to the NRC in July and August 2012 as originally planned.

MUAP-10006, Rev. 3, Soil-Structure Interaction and Results for the US-APWR Standard Plant
MUAP-12002, Rev. 1, Sliding Evaluation and Results
MUAP-11002, Rev. 2, T/B Model Properties, SSI Analyses, and Structural Integrity Evaluation
MUAP-11007 Rev 2, Water Table Effect Results

In addition, DCD markups identified in Table 3 of reference 1, and revised RAI responses identified in Table 4 of reference 1, will not be submitted prior to the end of August.
