Dear Mr. Popp:

We have completed our review of the Pharmacia & Upjohn Company LLC replacement Letter of Credit (L/C Number 103148-793) dated April 30, 2010; its first amendment dated January 13, 2012; and Standby Trust Agreement dated February 10, 2011, for NRC License No. 21-00182-03. Within the scope of our review, the financial assurance instruments were found to be acceptable.

As a result of the approval of these replacement decommissioning financial assurance instruments, we are canceling and returning an approved Parent Company Guarantee dated March 20, 1998; the CFO letter dated March 20, 1998; the Financial Test dated March 20, 1998; and the Auditor's Report dated March 20, 1998.

In addition, we are returning financial assurance documents that we had not completed action on that included a Standby Trust Agreement dated April 30, 2010; a Decommissioning Cost Estimate dated November 2008; and Parent Company Guarantee submittals for 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009.
