

RESOLUTION OF NUCLEAR INNOVATION NORTH AMERICA (NINA) AND
WESTINGHOUSE COMMENTS ON DRAFT SAFETY EVALUATION FOR TOPICAL REPORT
WCAP-17079-P FOR BWRS 2-6 “SUPPLEMENT 3 TO BISON
TOPICAL REPORT RPA 90-90-A SAFIR
CONTROL SYSTEM SIMULATOR”

By letter dated April 11, 2012 (ADAMS #ML12107A121), NINA and Westinghouse provided 19 comments on draft Safety Evaluation (SE) for Topical Report (TR) WCAP-17079-P for BWRs 2-6, “Supplement 3 to BISON Topical Report RPA 90-90-A SAFIR Control System Simulator.” Some information in the draft SER for this TR was identified by the applicant as proprietary and will be marked with brackets “[]” accordingly and the bracketed material will be removed from the public version of this SE.

Draft SE comments for TR WCAP-17079-P:

1. On page 3, paragraph 3, line 3, Westinghouse requests that “[]” be identified as proprietary. The NRC staff agreed and these items were removed from the public version of the SER.
2. On page 3, paragraph 3, lines 4, 5, and 9, Westinghouse requests that “[]” be identified as proprietary. The NRC staff agreed and these items were removed from the public version of the SER.
3. On page 5, paragraph 5, lines 1 through 3, Westinghouse requests that “[]” be identified as proprietary. The NRC staff agreed and these items were removed from the public version of the SER.
