

DEP invites you to review the attached GIF and comment on the land use aspects of this project; please be specific to DEP when identifying any areas of conflict. If you wish to submit comments for DEP to consider in a land use review of this project, you must respond within 30 days to the DEP regional office listed below. If there are no land use comments received by the end of the comment period, DEP will assume that there are no substantive land use conflicts and proceed with the normal application review process."

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
