This refers to your license amendment request dated May 18, 2012. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license naming Michael Malin, M.D. as your Radiation Safety Officer.

As discussed with your Office Managers, Chris Beaulieu and Beth Ouellette, by telephone on July 18 and 26, 2012, authorization for iodine-131 permitted by 10 CFR 35.300 including I-131 sodium iodide for imaging and localization studies has been removed from your license. In addition, the corresponding user authorizations for Drs. Bushey, Gibney, Gumbardo, Lehman, Malin, Olcese, and Ajemian have been removed from your license. Please note that you must request and receive an Amendment if you wish to restart this program.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
