- ▶ **Provide an opportunity for representatives from various stakeholder groups, and the public, to provide feedback on the proposed revision.**
- ▶ **Discuss opportunities for stakeholder and public involvement.**

How will the meetings be conducted?

NRC and FEMA representatives will discuss the revision process and proposed changes to NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1. Representatives from various stakeholder groups, reflecting the interests of State, local, industry, and non-governmental organizations, will then provide insights and recommendations on the proposed revision. Other stakeholders and interested members of the public will also be provided the opportunity to comment.

To enhance public involvement, teleconferencing and Web conferencing capabilities will be available for the meetings to allow for remote participation.
