Dear C. Jordan Weaver:

This letter is in reference to the petition for rulemaking (PRM), dated June 18, 2012 (NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML12177A377), that you filed electronically with the U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). You request that the NRC initiate a rulemaking "to revise its regulations to clearly and unequivocally require the environmental qualification of all safety-related cables, wires, splices, connections and other ancillary electrical equipment that may be subjected to submergence and/or moisture intrusion during normal operating conditions, severe weather, seasonal flooding, and seismic events, and post-accident conditions, both inside and outside of containment." The NRC docketed your petition pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 2.802, "Petition for rulemaking," on June 22, 2012, and assigned it Docket Number PRM-50-106. Please reference this docket number on any correspondence you may have concerning the petition.
