Dear Dr. Churchwell:

This is in reference to your current financial assurance instrument, a Parent Guarantee. The NRC published the new financial assurance rules in the Federal Register Notice dated June 17, 2011 [(Volume 76, No. 117, pages 35512 – 35573) ADAMS Accession Number ML121350224]. The NRC is revising 10 CFR 30.35 which applies to your Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 07-16199-01. The rule will be effective on December 17, 2012. The rule requires that those licensees who opted to use a parent guarantee for its financial assurance instrument must also have a standby trust fund to receive any funds from the licensee for decommissioning since the NRC cannot receive funds directly. Please review the Federal Register and provide the NRC with a signed original of a standby trust fund. Please respond before September 1, 2012. The NRC must review, resolve any discrepancies, and approve the standby trust fund before December 17, 2012.
