The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, has received two paper copies of your voluntarily offered International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Design Information Questionnaire (DIQ) for the URENCO USA (UUSA) Uranium Gas Centrifuge Enrichment Plant (GCEP) located in Eunice, NM. The NRC will notify UUSA when the completed pre-selection draft DIQ for the current life-cycle phase of the UUSA operational facility is forwarded to the IAEA Headquarters in Vienna, Austria, for examination. Please note that the DIQ cannot be verified until the GCEP facility has been selected for IAEA safeguards under the US-IAEA Safeguards Agreement or its Reporting Protocol, and the selection confirmed by the NRC.
