7/26/2012 (15:30) Dr. Hobson called concerning the letter regarding the licensee's financial assurance instrument and what was required by the Final Decommissioning Rule. She informed me that the licensee has a Parent Guarantee and not an Escrow Account and wanted clarification on what actions the licensee needed to take. I looked over my list and confirmed the information that she provided me. I apologized for using the wrong template and explained how the Decommissioning Rule still applied in the licensee's case. The licensee's financial assurance instrument was a Parent Guarantee and the Rule now required licensee's using such instruments to also have a Standby Trust Agreement in place. The Trust would be necessary to receive funds if the licensee determines that decommissioning should begin since the NRC cannot receive funds for decommissioning directly. Dr. Hobson asked if there was any guidance on how to write a Standby Trust Agreement. I directed her to NUREG-1757, Volume 3, starting on page A-153. She also requested that a new letter be typed up with the proper request for a Standby Trust Agreement which she could present to management. I informed her that it would probably arrive in about ten days.
