### NOTICE (Scheduling Prehearing Conference Call)

The Board will convene a prehearing conference call on Tuesday, September 25, 2012, at 2:00 PM EDT to review and discuss the progress of this proceeding. The primary purpose of the prehearing conference will be to discuss and resolve issues related to the fair and efficient conduct of the evidentiary hearing, scheduled to commence on October 31, 2012. One counsel from Progress Energy Florida, Inc., the Intervenors (Nuclear Information and Resource Service and the Ecology Party of Florida), and the NRC Staff shall participate in the conference call.

In addition, the Board notifies the parties that on August 3, 2012, the NRC amended its regulations related to Part 2 adjudicatory proceedings.<sup>1</sup> Among other things, these amendments relax the rules regarding the Staff's mandatory disclosure duties and change the rules regarding the admission of new contentions. <u>Id.</u> at 46,591-92; 46,593-94. These new final regulations apply to this adjudication with regard to "obligations and disputes that arise after the effective date" of the rule. <u>Id.</u> at 46,562. The effective date is September 4, 2012. <u>Id.</u> During the September 25, 2012 conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss the impact, if

initial scheduling order, or other orders governing the future conduct of this proceeding.
