Hello Susan and Jose:

I write with a brief update on the Alco bankruptcy case. We continue to monitor the sale of Alco's various assets in this proceeding to ensure that Alco does not try to transfer any of the NRC-permitted devices to a third party. Yesterday the Court authorized the sale of Alco's Hatillo facility. Although there are no NRC-permitted devices at the Hatillo facility, out of an abundance of caution (since the devices are mobile) we still secured the inclusion of our standard DOJ "fix" language in the Hatillo sale order (see paragraph 20 of the attached order).

Alco is still trying to unload other assets so there very likely will be additional sales for us to continue to follow. We will keep you posted as the case progresses. Best regards. Ruben
