SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING WITH FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT TO  
DISCUSS THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW RELATED TO TURKEY  
POINT UNITS 6 AND 7 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION -  
SOCIOECOMONICS

On Wednesday, July 25, 2012, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 1 public teleconference with representatives of Florida Power and Light's (FPL) regarding the environmental review for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 combined licenses (COLs). A list of participants is enclosed (Enclosure 1). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the incorporation of U. S. Census Bureau 2005-2009 American Community Survey (ACS) data updates to Chapter 2 of the applicant's environmental report (ER) and Chapter 2.1 of the final safety analysis report (FSAR). The staff did not address the issue of including ACS data in the assessment of alternative sites.

The teleconference began with introductions from the NRC staff, representatives from FPL, and members of the public. Next, FPL led the technical discussion by describing how the ER socioeconomic population data and FSAR chapter 2.1.3 population distribution data would be updated in the next revision to the COL application. This updated data would be from the ACS 2005-2009 five-year summary files database for socioeconomic population data, but from the 2010 Census for chapter 2.1.3 of the FSAR. In closing, FPL indicated the NRC staff can expect to see this updated data in the annual COL application update that takes places in December 2012.

No questions or comments from the public were received. The meeting was adjourned.
