Dear Mr. Smith:

This letter confirms that the pre-decisional enforcement conference we requested has been scheduled for August 27, 2012, at 10:30 a.m. (EST). The purpose of the conference is to discuss the apparent violations associated with the failure to identify credible accident sequences related to seismic events and tornadoes that could result in large uranium hexafluoride (UF₆) releases for which protective actions may be needed. These apparent violations are documented in NRC Temporary Instruction 2600-015 Inspection Report No. 40-3392/2012-006. The location of the conference will be at the NRC Region II Office, Marquis One Tower, 245 Peachtree Center Avenue, N.E., Suite 1200, Atlanta, Georgia 30303. This will be a Category 1 meeting in which the public is invited to observe. Members of the public will have the opportunity to communicate with the NRC staff after the business portion, but before the conference is adjourned, as per the NRC policy statement, "Enhancing Public Participation in NRC Meetings," published in the Federal Register: May 28, 2002 (Volume 67, Number 102, Pages 36920-36924).

This will ensure that sufficient copies of conference materials are available.
