SUBJECT: OFFERING LETTER FOR PROPOSED 8(a) PROCUREMENT (RFPA NO. ADM-11-345), FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES ENTITLED "Automated Acquisition Management System (AAMS)" TO SUPPORT NRC DIVISION OF CONTRACTS OFFICES

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is an agency offering that is being submitted pursuant to Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 19.804-2, Agency offering and the associated Memorandum of Understanding between the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). As required by that FAR Subpart, the following information is provided for SBA's consideration:

(1) A description of the work to be performed or items to be delivered, and a copy of the statement of work, if available: Information technology support services relating to NRC's Automated Acquisition Management System (AAMS) support and Federal Procurement Data System-Next Generation (FPDS-NG) support. A copy of the Statement of Work for the intended time and material contract is enclosed.

(2) The estimated period of performance: One year base, beginning on or about August 2011, with (3) one year option periods.

(3) The NAICS code that applies to the principal nature of the acquisition: 541519

(4) The anticipated dollar value of the requirement, including options, if any: \$4,000,000.00 (not to exceed)

(5) Any special restrictions or geographical limitations on the requirement (for construction, include the location of the work to be performed): N/A

(6) Any special capabilities or disciplines needed for contract performance: Familiarity with NRC's AAMS Systems capabilities and division of contracts.

(7) The type of contract anticipated: Time and Materials (T&M) contract type.

(8) The acquisition history, if any, of the requirement, including the names and addresses of any small business contractors that have performed this requirement during the previous 24 months: Under a current 8(a) sole source contract awarded by the NRC (Contract No. NRC-10-10-1221), Centeva, LLC., located at 1505 Misty Fen Way, West Jordan, UT 84088-6588 performed related support services for the NRC Office of Administration, Division of Contracts. This contract covered services to include AAMS support, training for NRC staff on how to use AAMS and FPDS operational support services. The contract has been an overwhelming success.
