8/2/2012 (08:15) I left a message on Ms. Stemen's voice-mail to call me so that a status update could be provided. (13:00) Ms. Stemen's returned my call. Ms. Stemen's stated that she is still putting together the required documents to (1) combine the SNM and irradiator licenses with the broad scope license, (2) change the Self-guarantee (SG) to reflect the changes required by (1), and complete the Standby Trust Agreement (STA). Her financial department wanted to know why the STA was required and if there was any guidance on how to write it. I replied that the STA is required of all licensees that have SG and is used as a repository of funds if the SG should be activated. The NRC cannot receive funds directly as the funds would only go into the General Fund and would not be available for decommissioning. A model STA can be found in NUREG-1757, Volume 3 at page A-153. If she had any further questions, she could call me or Dennis Lawyer.
