PURPOSE: On July 30, 2012, a Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.206 petition was submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting that the NRC take enforcement-related action against all NRC licensees as a result of information provided on a Bloomberg News Agency broadcast which described a cybersecurity incident at Diablo Canyon (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML12215A022). The purpose of this meeting is to provide the petitioner with an opportunity to address the NRC Petition Review Board (PRB), pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206.

CATEGORY 3:* This is a Category 3 public meeting, where the public is normally invited to participate in the meeting by providing comments and asking questions throughout the meeting. In this instance, the public will have an opportunity to ask questions pertaining only to the 10 CFR 2.206 processes, after the petitioner completes his uninterrupted presentation to PRB.
