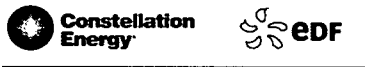

By letter dated May 25, 2011 (Reference a), the NRC issued Order EA-11-081 to Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, LLC (NMPNS) regarding additional security measures (ASMs) for the NMPNS Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). The Order imposes requirements as set forth in Attachments 1 and 2 to the Order, and requires responses and actions within timeframes specified in Sections III.A, III.B, and III.C of the Order. NMPNS consented to the Order in References (b) and (c).

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Section III.C.2 of the Order requires that NMPNS report to the Commission when it has achieved full compliance with the requirements described in Attachments 1 and 2 of the Order. This letter provides notification to the NRC that NMPNS is in full compliance with the requirements described in Attachments 1 and 2 of the Order.
