SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JULY 12, 2012, MEETING WITH HOLTEC  
INTERNATIONAL TO DISCUSS THE PAD ANALYSIS  
METHODOLOGY

### Background

A meeting was held on July 12, 2012, in Rockville, Maryland, at the request of Holtec International to discuss Holtec's methodology for seismic/structural analysis of reinforced concrete pads for independent spent fuel storage installations (ISFSIs). The enclosures are the agenda, the list of meeting attendees, and a copy of the presentation slides presented by Holtec. NRC staff made observations on the information presented by Holtec, and openly exchanged technical and regulatory information; however, no regulatory decisions were made nor requested at the meeting.

### Discussion

- The purpose of the meeting was for Holtec to present information on the analysis/design requirements for ISFSI pads, a background on their analysis, the soil structure interaction analysis, and ISFSI pad strength and stability evaluation per the American Concrete Institute (ACI) code.
- The staff and Holtec engaged in discussions regarding the ISFSI storage pad and its FSAR designation as "not-important-to-safety," as well as the use of ACI-318 for the pad's qualification, rather than using ACI-349, as a consensus standard for evaluating the structural adequacy of the concrete pad.
- During Holtec's presentation of the rocking coefficient of restitution (COR), the staff indicated that they wanted to provide comments to Holtec on their methodology for calculating the COR after the presentation. The staff was not able to warrant any comments on the rocking COR. The staff would like to follow up in another public meeting to discuss Holtec's methodology for calculating the rocking COR.

- Holtec expressed their intent to submit a letter presenting their methodology and requesting staff feedback in a response letter.
- Industry representatives participated via teleconference. There was no participation from members of the general public.
