SUBJECT: REQUEST TO REPRESENT THE NRC WHILE ON PERSONAL TRAVEL

On July 23, 2012, Dr. James Chang indicated that he planned to travel to Taiwan on personal travel, and requested permission to use this opportunity to meet with counterparts at the Taiwan Atomic Energy Council, the Institute of Nuclear Energy Research (AEC/INER), and the Long-Men nuclear power station. The purpose of these meetings would be to study the fully digitized advanced simulator facilities and exchange information on Dr. Chang's SACADA data project, with the goal of setting the groundwork for an international data exchange cooperative agreement with his Taiwanese counterparts. Dr. Chang requested to meet with the INER staff on August 22, 2012 and the Long-Men Nuclear Power Station staff on August 21, 2012. In his request, Dr. Chang specifically indicated that he would not seek any reimbursement for travel costs.

It is my belief that Dr. Chang's proposed work would fully support the NRC's mission and the Human Factors and Reliability Branch's goal of enhancing the state-of-the-art in human factors and human reliability analysis. Therefore, as Dr. Chang's Branch Chief, I authorize Dr. Chang to represent the NRC and charge the agency for his time preparing for and attending the above meetings. The purpose of Dr. Chang's trip to Taiwan is primarily for personal vacation, and he specifically requested not to seek a travel reimbursement; therefore, I will respect his wishes, and will not authorize a travel reimbursement for these meetings. Upon completion of his travel, Dr. Chang will prepare a trip report summarizing the above meetings.

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
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
