The licensee did not respond to the fee invoices. I discussed the issue with Diane Hannah. She stated that she did not know anything about the license or licensed material and that the company was sold to West Virginia Paving (WVP), and hence does not exist any longer. I asked her if the gauges were also included in the sold assets, and she stated that WVP would not accept the gauges (during the conversation she became belligerent and blamed the NRC for giving the company a license). I explained to her that the fee would keep on accumulating until the license is terminated and that she will need to dispose of the gauges by transfer to an authorized recipient. Not getting anywhere with her, I called Andrew Scott, who is the financial consultant to Diane's business.

He was very cooperative and I explained to him the options available to them with regard to NRC license. He promised to follow up with Diane and her husband and get back to me.
