Pioneer Drilling Company (NYSE: PDC) announced that its name has changed to Pioneer Energy Services Corp., effective July 31, 2012. The Company's common stock will continue to trade on the New York Stock Exchange but will trade under the new ticker symbol "PES." Pioneer's website is now www.pioneeres.com.

Over the last five years, the Company has transformed from a pure play domestic land contract driller to a diversified energy services provider with operations across the United States and in Columbia. Today, approximately 50% of the Company's revenues and operating margin are derived from its Production Services Segment. The Company operates 102 well servicing rigs, 117 wireline units, 11 coiled tubing units and an array of fishing and rental tools in addition to 66 drilling rigs. The Company's core services are heavily concentrated in the Bakken, Eagle Ford, and Permian and along the Gulf Coast, both onshore and offshore. The new name reflects who Pioneer is today.

In connection with the name change, the Company's common stock was assigned the new CUSIP number 723664 108. The Company's outstanding common stock certificates are not affected by the name change and they continue to be valid.





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The structure for Pioneer Energy Services Corp is organized as follows:




The organizational structure within the Wireline Business Unit has essentially remained the same and is presented as follows:



The organizational responsibilities within the Wireline Business Unit are presented from the District storage and usage level through the Division Level Radiation Safety Officer for the License (Agreement State and NRC) through Region Management (Gulf Coast & North) to the Business Unit Vice-President to the Business Segment President to the President and CEO of the Corporation.

In summary, the proposed changes to the Company are a corporate name change and a minor change to the organizational structure. The following information with respect to the radiation safety program is acknowledged:

- The new name for the Corporation is Pioneer Energy Services Corp and Pioneer Wireline Services, LLC remains a business unit of Pioneer Production Services, a segment of Pioneer Energy Services. The radioactive materials license should reflect the name "Pioneer Wireline Services, LLC";
- 2. The "dba" brand under which the License previously operated Competition Wireline Services is discontinued. The business unit offices where radioactive materials are stored (7069 Niehenke Ave, Billings, MT 59101; #4 Hole Brothers Road, Cut Bank, MT 59427; 2320 Second Street West, Havre, MT 59501; 1316 Willer Drive, Casper, WY 82604; and all operations in the outer continental shelf "OCSG" Gulf of Mexico) will operate under the name Pioneer Wireline Services, LLC.
- 3. The Radiation Safety Officer for NRC License No 25-27802-01, Docket No 030-36849 remains Mr. George Doggett. Mr. Doggett continues to reside and office in Lafayette, LA. Mr. Doggett answers directly to Mr. Bill Bouziden, Vice-President, Gulf Coast Region and Mr. Monte Doenz, Vice-President, Northern Region as well as Mr. Martin O'Neil, Vice-President, Pioneer Wireline Services, LLC business unit. Mr. Bouziden and Mr. Doenz answers directly to Mr. Martin O'Neil, Vice-President Pioneer Wireline Services, LLC. Mr. Bouziden resides in the Corporate San Antonio office while both Mr. Doenz and Mr. O'Neil office in Billings, MT. Mr. O'Neil answers directly to Mr. Joe Eustace, President, Production Services Segment. Mr. Eustace answers directly to Mr. Stacy Locke, President and CEO, Pioneer Energy Services Corp. Mr. Eustace and Mr. Locke office in the Company's corporate offices located in San Antonio, Texas.
- Mr. George Doggett, HSE Director, continues to function as the Corporate Radiation Safety
 Officer and answers directly to Mr. O'Neil. Mr. Doggett resides and offices in Lafayette, LA.
- 5. There are no changes in personnel having control over licensed activities; there are no changes in any personnel named in the license such as Radiation Safety Officers, authorized users, or any other persons identified in previous license applications as responsible for radiation safety or use of licensed material.
- 6. There are no changes in training criteria including the qualifications, training, and responsibilities of new individuals.
- 7. There are no changes in the officers of the corporation.
- There have been no transfers of stocks or assets. There have been no mergers. There has been
 no transfer of control. The actions discussed in this announcement are intended to notify the
 Agency that this is a name change only.
- 9. There are no planned changes in the organization, location, facility, equipment, or procedures (operating and emergency procedures will remain the same as previously submitted in the license renewal application).
- There are no planned changes in the use, possession, location, or storage of the licensed materials.

- 11. There are no changes in the surveillance activities (e.g. calibrations, leak tests, surveys, inventories, and accountability requirements) and all surveillance requirements, records and documents are current.
- 12. The Company confirms that it will abide by all commitments and representations made previously to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in accordance with the terms and conditions of its radioactive materials license.

In conclusion, there are no changes in the management organization. The Corporation remains the same. Ownership of the company remains the same. Responsibilities for the day-to-day operations remain the same. The organization is rebranding its name and enabling some internal restructuring.
