Work activities will consist of collection of smear samples to assess potential levels of tritium contamination and decontamination activities associated with damage to ten tritium exit signs. Based on experience at similar sites, potential removable tritium contamination levels are expected to be above Regulatory Guide 1.86 levels. All wastes from the sampling and decontamination activities will be secured at the site and packaged along with the damaged signs until transfer to a licensed waste broker can be arranged.
