Dear Mr. Hankins:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 171.16, Caribbean Inspection & NDT Services (CIS) is required to pay an annual fee for NRC License No. 52-25629-01. NRC sent to CIS an invoice dated July 6, 2011, and subsequently a second notice on September 8, 2011, requesting payment. Not having received the payment, the NRC issued to CIS an Order dated June 4, 2012, which stated, in part, that failure to pay all debts within 20 days from the date of the Order, will result in revocation of the license by the terms of the Order and, in the future, CIS will not be able to operate under License No. 52-25629-01.

As of June 25, 2012, a period of more than 20 days had elapsed from the date of the Order and you had not paid all debts to the NRC. Therefore, in accordance with the terms of the Order your license was revoked as of June 25, 2012.

Pursuant to the Order, you submitted an NRC Form 314, Certificate of Disposition of Materials, dated August 13, 2012, certifying that all activities authorized by NRC License No. 52-25629-01 have ceased, and all radioactive materials acquired and/or possessed under the license have been transferred to another authorized recipient. You further stated that no final radiation survey of your facility was necessary because you only possessed sealed sources and no leaking sources were ever identified.

Based on the information contained in your NRC Form 314, your license is retired. You may release for unrestricted use, all facilities previously used for licensed activities. Please be reminded that NRC will not approve any future application by you for a license until all debts owed to the NRC are paid in full.
