Dear Mr. Fegel:

This refers to your letter and a letter from NRD Holdings LLC both dated July 17, 2012, describing the proposed transfer of control of your licensed activities to NRD Holdings LLC. From the letters, we understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensed name, location of use, materials, persons using licensed material, or persons responsible for radiation safety at the licensed facility.

Based on the above understandings, we have no objection to this transfer. Future changes in the licensed name, use, location, persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
