On May 23, 2012- Premier Diagnostic Imaging (PDI), 135 East McCallister Drive, Terre Haute, IN 47802 was acquired by Terre Haute Regional Hospital, 3901 South 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Terre Haute, IN. PDI was issued the above referenced Radioactive Material License. The name will remain the same. No nuclear medicine procedures have been performed since January 2012 and no radiation materials will be acquired for PDI until the transfer of control has been approved by the NRC. Radioactive material will be received, used and stored in accordance with the regulations and the statements in the license application. The location, facility and equipment will be as stated as in the original PDI license. All records concerning the surveillance program (surveys, wipe tests, and quality control procedures) will be maintained at the facility. No changes will be made to the existing program until approved by the Radiation Safety committee and the NRC when required by licensing conditions or regulations.

The authorized users for medical uses and the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Edward Johnston, will be as listed on the attached License No. 13-09649-02 issued to Terre Haute Regional Hospital. 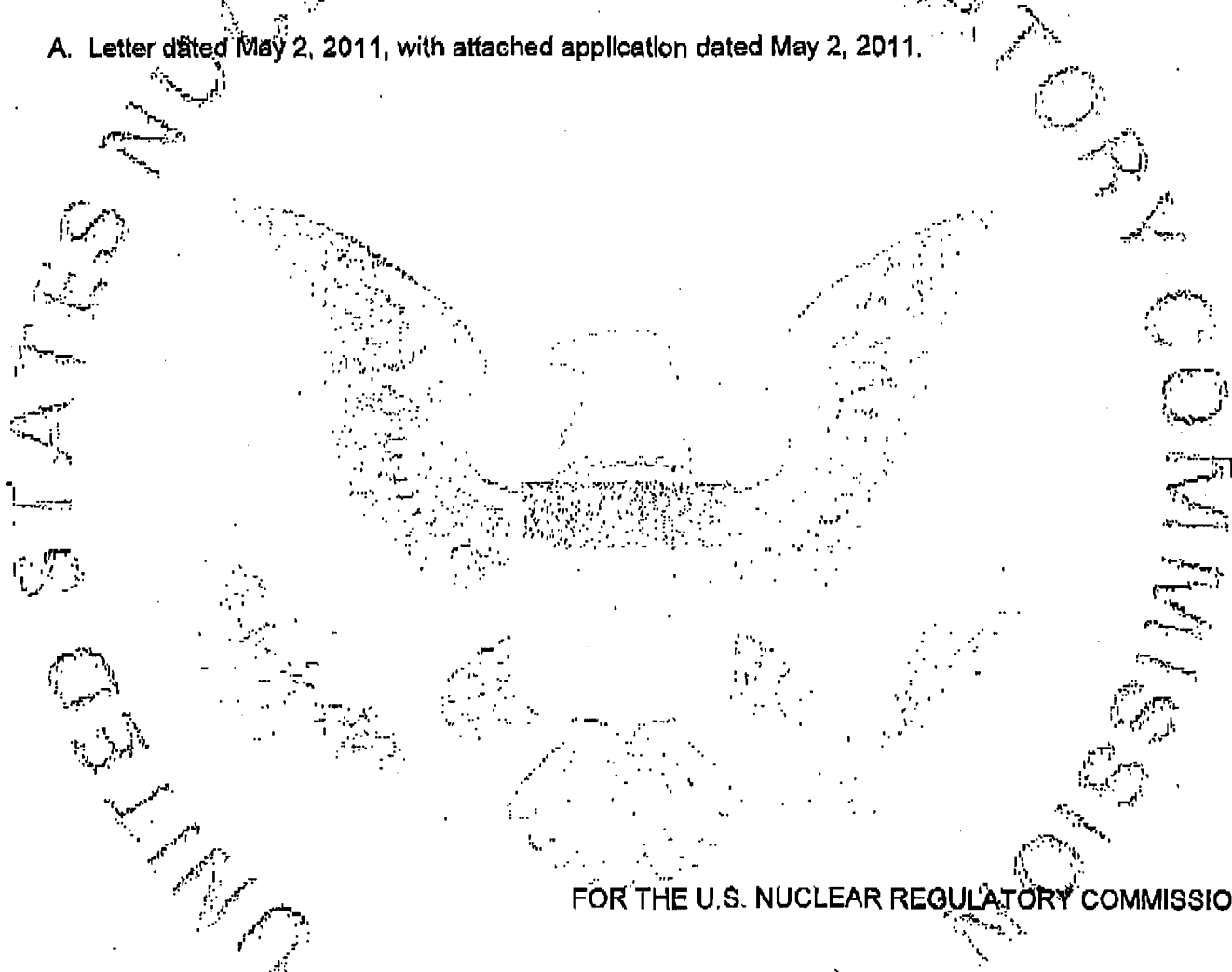
