In Reference 1, Exelon Nuclear Texas Holdings, LLC (Exelon) submitted an application for an early site permit (ESP) for the Victoria County Station (VCS) site. In Reference 2, Exelon submitted Revision 1 to the VCS ESP Application.

Exelon has reassessed the economic viability of new nuclear plant construction in the merchant generation market, and based on several factors contributing to an unfavorable economic outlook, Exelon has made the decision to cancel the VCS ESP project. Accordingly, Exelon hereby requests that the VCS Early Site Permit Application, submitted in References 1 and 2, be withdrawn.
