Dear Ms. Staton:

This is in reference to your letter dated June 7, 2012 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 42-27593-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please a name an individual as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Currently, there are two RSO's on the license, and the NRC does not list multiple RSO's on a license. The RSO is responsible for the overall management of the radiation safety program; identifying radiation safety problems, initiating, recommending or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; ensuring compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and conditions of the license. An RSO should actively participate in the day-to-day management of the radiation safety program. Although the performance of certain radiation safety tasks may be delegated by the RSO to other individuals (such as an alternate Radiation Safety Officer), the responsibility for the overall effectiveness of the radiation safety program and for compliance with NRC rules and regulations and conditions of the license reside with the RSO named on the license.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material**; then **Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region IV Office and refer to Mail Control No. 577702. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call me at (817) 200-1596.

If we do not receive a reply from you by **August 30, 2012**, we will keep the RSO as Gayle Staton and remove Chris Dixon. Please note, both individuals will be in our licensing tracking system to allow them to submit amendment requests.
