Dear Mr. Murray:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has completed the review of changes to Chapters 2, 4, and 11 of the License Application, submitted via your letter SPM-12-036 dated August 16, 2012.

Our review has determined that the changes were appropriately made in accordance with the requirements of Section 1.3.1.2 of the License Application, as well as Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 70.72, and that prior NRC approval of these changes were not required. It is understood that this request was submitted in order to ensure that the current text appears in all controlled copies of the License Application.

Pursuant to Part 70 to 10 CFR, Materials License SNM-1097 is hereby amended to include the revised text in Chapters 2, 4, and 11.

Safety Condition S-1 has been revised to include the date of August 16, 2012.

The Technical Assignment Control Number L33232 is considered CLOSED.
