SUBJECT: RESCISSION OF ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSES AUTHORIZING  
EXPORTS TO LIBYA (PXB142.00)

Dear Mr. Martinez:

In light of the suspension of the Executive Order of February 25, 2011, "Blocking Property and Prohibiting Certain Transactions Related to Libya", the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) hereby rescinds the Order Suspending Licenses for exports to Libya dated August 2, 2012. The licenses affected by the Order included NRC specific license PXB142.00 and general licenses authorizing exports of source, special nuclear or byproduct materials in accordance with 10 C.F.R. Part 110.

If you currently hold a specific license authorizing exports to Libya that has an expiration date beyond the date of receipt of this notice, your license will automatically become effective again and you will be authorized to resume making shipments to Libya, in accordance with that license, without any further action by the NRC.
