Westinghouse Electric Company, LLC “Westinghouse” submits a revision of the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan for the Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility. This revision consists of changes processed in accordance with Materials License SNM-1107 Safeguards Condition SG-1.1. The changes are identified by marginal lines, with descriptions of the changes provided in the revision record.

Substantive changes include incorporation of a management change to the Columbia Plants Environmental Health and Safety Department. The former Licensing and Regulatory Programs management function has been divided, with the Regulatory Programs Manager now responsible for the implementation of the Safeguards function including Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan required procedures. The Licensing Manager retains control of the license documents, including the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan, to ensure compliance with the governing regulations and provide for necessary document control. Improvements identified during the most recent Safeguards Assessment are also included in this revision. All chapters were updated to revision 42 to ensure consistent revision number for document and record control. This revision does not decrease the effectiveness of the plan and is processed in accordance with and pursuant to 10 CFR 70.32(c)(2).

Westinghouse requests that the enclosures to this letter be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d). This revision is administrative in nature. The revision does not adversely affect public health and safety or the environment, presents no construction impact, and Westinghouse requests that this revision be processed in accordance with the categorical exclusion provision of 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11).
