Good Morning Mr. Abrams,

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is currently reviewing a Combined License Application for a new nuclear reactor at Pennsylvania Power and Light's Bell Bend site near Berwick, Pennsylvania. Information regarding the NRC's review of the application can be found at <http://www.nrc.gov/reactors/new-reactors/col/bell-bend.html>. As part of the review of the COL application, the NRC is preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Baltimore District, is a cooperating agency. The NRC and the USACE are consulting in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).

As part of the Section 106 consultation process, the NRC and USACE staff sent a letter to the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin on June 12, 2012 (attached). In a June 21, 2012 response (attached) the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin indicated they have no current concerns with respect to the Bell Bend Combined License Application review. However, Ms. Corina Williams indicated that the NRC and USACE staff should consult with the Haudenosaunee Council in order to gain a further understanding of potential cultural resources impacts to other Wisconsin Tribes. Ms. Williams also indicated that the NRC and USACE staff should contact you and provided your email.

In order to ensure that the NRC and USACE are contacting the Haudenosaunee Council correctly, could you please provide us with the contact information (including mailing address) for the Haudenosaunee Council?
