Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse) hereby submits a revised Physical Security Plan, Revision 42, for the Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (CFFF). This revision is submitted in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 70.32(e) and SNM-1107 Materials License Safeguards Condition SG-2.1.

Engineering processed the necessary configuration control (CCF) changes to install an annex Uranium Hexafluoride Container Storage Pad within the CAA boundary. The CCF changes were evaluated by Westinghouse and determined to not decrease the effectiveness of the plan for the physical protection of Special Nuclear Material in accordance with the requirements outlined in 10 CFR 70.32(e) and SNM-1107 Materials License Safeguards Condition SG-2.1. The use of the newly installed storage positions does not necessitate changes to the currently authorized material possession limits of the SNM-1107 Materials License.


The enclosed page changes constitute Revision 42 of the SNM -1107 Physical Security Plan (PSP).
