**Subject:** Renewal License Application Clarifying Questions

I called Mr. McCasland to clarify the accuracy of information submitted in their renewal license application dated August 16, 2012.

- 1: I mentioned to Mr. McCasland that he had requested storage locations in New York, an Agreement State and that we were unable to do so. I reminded him we could only authorize for temporary jobsite use in areas of Federal jurisdiction.
- 2: I also inquired about the maximum number of devices they would routinely use in areas of Federal jurisdiction at any one time. He stated that the most he would have in use in areas of exclusive Federal jurisdiction would be ten (10). I told him that we would put a maximum of 10 devices on the license and that he would need an amendment to change that number in the future if more devices were necessary.

I stated that the license should be issued sometime next week. I thanked him for his time and ended the call

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
