Purpose

The purpose of this letter is to submit for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review and approval proposed changes to the Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation Security Program, CW-SP-01.

Background

When Curtis-Wright Electro-Mechanical Division (CW-EMD) initially submitted its Security Program to your office, a process was not in place to accommodate proper handling of classified matter that was to be shipped or received via overnight carrier. Accordingly, this provision was not included in the Security Program. CW-EMD has since developed and validated procedures

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for the proper handling of classified overnight shipping and receiving and has determined the need for necessary changes to CW-SP-01 as described below.

Discussion

CW-EMD is proposing to change its Security Program to incorporate the ability to conduct classified overnight shipping and receiving. This change is reflected in Sections 3.4 and 14.2.1 of the Enclosure 1. Only the affected pages of CW-SP-01 are provided.

Enclosure 1 contains USEC Proprietary Information and Security-Related Information, therefore, USEC requests they be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* 2.390(d)(1). Enclosure 1 has also been determined, in accordance with the guidance provided by the U.S. Department of Energy, to be for Official Use Only.


Action
