I am responding to your July 31, 2012 letter requesting the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review and comment on the Draft Completion Review Report (CRR) for the license termination of the Holiday/EI Mesquite and O'Hern Project sites (Texas Radioactive Material License No. R03024) located near Bruni, Texas.

The NRC staff review of this submittal is assigned to Stephen Poy, who will review of the Draft and Final CRR prior to the final concurrence determination. The Draft CRR will be reviewed in accordance with the criteria in the Office of Federal State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-900: *Termination of Uranium Milling Licenses in Agreement States*. FSME Procedure SA-900 describes NRC's review process for making the determination that all applicable standards and requirements have been met prior to Agreement State uranium milling license termination, as required by 10 CFR 150.15a(a) and Section 274c of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Our goal is to review the Draft CRR and provide the results of our review within 60 days from the date of this letter.

We appreciate the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's effort to follow the suggested format in FSME Procedure SA-900. If during our review it is determined that additional information is required, we will contact you.
