Dear Sir or Madam:

On August 10, 2012 Global Nuclear Fuel – Americas L.L.C. (GNF-A) submitted a 30 day written report in response to Event Notification 48100 (Reference 3). The immediate and short-term corrective actions have been completed for this event.

The longer-term preventive action was to submit a license amendment to NRC to remove CAAS requirements from WFSC with a schedule completion date of September 14, 2012. This request is taking longer than anticipated. As a result, GNF-A is submitting a revised scheduled date as shown.
