1. Please note that the letter from Saint Julian Snider requests an administrative permit amendment to officially change the name of CLC to: Lhoist North America of Arizona, Inc. However, on the information required for change of control and/or change of ownership (including a name change), Item 1.B., the new name of the licensed organization is specified as Lhoist North America.

Please clarify this discrepancy.

2. Because your license is currently authorized for possession and storage in standby mode and the license must be amended prior to any use, please include an acceptable accountability program for assuring that the licensed material remains in secure storage and is not used (inventory at least annually). The program provides reasonable assurance that the licensee will maintain security.
3. On your supplemental information response to NRC Form 313 for Items 5 through 11, Items 6, 10.1, and 10.2 are addressed as if the licensee is authorized for normal authorized use and/or operations. However, because your license is currently authorized for possession and storage in standby mode, please describe all planned changes to limit/decrease the licensee's radiation safety program as a result of placing the licensed material in storage. These changes may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Dosimetry services
 - b. Worker training programs
 - c. Instrument calibration services
 - d. Inventories
 - e. Internal audits
 - f. Maintenance and visual inspection of equipment and facilities
 - g. Maintenance of records
4. Please include a commitment to leak test sealed sources and devices containing sealed sources at least once every 10 years and within 6 months before use or transfer to an authorized recipient.
