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Dear Ms. Roldan-Otero,

In your e-mail dated August 31, 2012 you requested American Engineering Testing, Inc. (AET) provide additional information so you could continue your review of our portable gauge license renewal request. Our responses are as follows:

1. AET will either possess and use, or have access to and use, a radiation survey meter that meets the Criteria in section entitled "Radiation Safety Program – Instruments" in NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, dated November 2001.
2. AET will conduct physical inventories at intervals not to exceed 6 months, to account for all sealed sources and devices received and possessed under the license.
3. AET will implement and maintain the operating, emergency and security procedures in Errata: Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, dated November 2011, and provide copies of these procedures to all gauge users and at each job site.
4. AET will send the gauge to the manufacturer or other person authorized by NRC or an Agreement State to perform non-routine maintenance or repair operations that require the removal of the source or source rod from the gauge.
