This is in reference to your letter received February 28, 2002 requesting an amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 50-23289-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. In order to name Mr. Martin Dimas on License Condition 17 A, please show documentation showing Mr. Dimas has received training in the areas of installation, initial radiation surveys, relocation, or removal from service of gauges. The certificates you provided were for Radiation Safety Officer training. If the aforementioned training was included in the Radiation Safety training, please provide the syllabus of the specific training.

If we do not receive a reply from you by **May 17, 2012** we will assume that you do not wish to pursue this part of the license amendment request and will issue a partial amendment modifying your possession limit for Cesium-137 as requested. .
