Sorry to bother you again, but are you close to sending a reply? I'm asking because we have to meet with the Susquehanna River Basin Committee in Harrisburg, PA on Friday, and then drive to this "Martins Creek" site on Monday morning, and it would help us to know if this site is eligible to be a "candidate" alternative site, or if it's potentially licensable, so we could decide how much (if any) time and effort we should spend analyzing it. According to our "Environmental Standard Review Plan" guidance (p. 9.3-9 and -10 in <http://pbadupws.nrc.gov/docs/ML0718/ML071800223.pdf>), to be a candidate site, "There should be no preemption of or adverse impacts on land specially designated for environmental, recreational, or other special purposes."
