Were you close to sending an answer to my question RE: If PPL (the Bell Bend nuclear plant license applicant) could somehow avoid the need for permits for water allocation and tying into the Highlands wastewater utilities infrastructure, could it avoid complying with the Highlands RMP provisions and be granted a construction permit for the Martins Creek site? (i.e., Could PPL avoid these permits by withdrawing and discharging water to the Delaware River only?) [I'm asking because the issue came up again today in a meeting in which someone stated that a candidate alternative site would not be viable if it was not reasonable to assume that a construction permit would be granted at that site.]
