Re: Hearing on Indian Point Nuclear Reactors.

I am writing to ask you to close Indian Point when its current 40 year license expires. To extend this plant's operation for another 20 years as requested by Entergy is to extend the ongoing environmental damage to water and marine life in the Hudson River. It is a nuclear disaster waiting to happen and there is no viable way to evacuate citizens in the greater New York area should that happen. Existing plans for evacuation are an exercise in sheer fantasy. Besides the environmental destruction and risk to millions of people, NY does not need Indian Point's power according to a 2011 study by Riverkeeper and NRDC. Necessary energy supplies can be provided in the future by renewable energy, greater efficiencies and transmission.
